



## David Vincent Wechtaluk

January 20, 1949 - December 26, 2021

David Vincent Wechtaluk, of Blacksburg, Virginia, passed away on December 26, 2021, at the age of 72 after a 20-year battle with Parkinson's Disease. David was a lifelong sports enthusiast and athlete, having played baseball and basketball in high school and college, and a strong supporter of Virginia Tech athletics and his children's other alma maters, Purdue University and Penn State. Born January 20, 1949, in Elmira Heights, New York, David was a proud graduate of Rider University (Lawrence Township, New Jersey). He had a long career in the accounting field, working for Park Broadcasting (Ithaca, New York), St. Elizabeth's Hospital (Lincoln, Nebraska) where both of his children were born, and Montgomery County (Virginia) Department of Social Services.
