John Arthur Brotherton, 77, of Blacksburg, Virginia, passed away on August 15th, 2023. He was born on June 5, 1946. After graduating from Blacksburg High School, he attended Ferrum College. He served in the United States National Guard before becoming a police officer at VT, where he retired as a Captain after 30 years.
