Pamela Sinnott Miller, 74, passed away peacefully on February 6th, 2022, at her home in Blacksburg, VA. Memorial services will be held at McCoy Funeral Home in Blacksburg, VA on Saturday February 12th at 5pm. The family will receive friends from 4pm until the service.

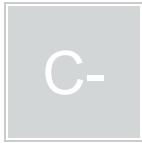
