When they moved to Christiansburg, it was not unusual to find her with a sledge hammer knocking out walls, laying tile, or building a fireplace. A woman of many talents, she won awards for her flower arrangements, her art work, and as best friend and “adopted mom” to all who entered her door. She was the owner of Paint Brush Gallery, the first frame shop in the area. Rosalie loved to host huge meals for her family and will be remembered for the life size nativity she built that stopped traffic on Main Street for many years. She was always ready for a new experience and traveled to China, Europe, the Caribbean and anywhere her children or grandchildren lived. She will be achingly missed by her daughters Jennie Reilly (Mike) and Linda Dalton; her grandchildren John Kelley (Margie), Alan Trout (Rachel), Elizabeth Dalton (Keith), Zack Trout (Stephanie) and her five Great Granddaughters.
