Vickie Kay Olinger Graham, 75, of Longshop, Virginia, entered her heavenly home on May 30, 2025. She was preceded in death by her parents, Harry Conway Olinger and Marguerite Dayne McCoy Olinger, as well as several brothers-in-law and sisters-in-law.

Vickie was known for her warm, welcoming, contagious smile, and genuine spirit.
